



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-046**

**AN ORDER IMPLEMENTING THE ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY AND COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN SELECTED AREAS/BARANGAYS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MIAGAO UNTIL AUGUST 31, 2020 FOR STRONGER PROTECTION AGAINST THE CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)**

WHEREAS, the Municipal Health Office and the Local Task Force Against Covid-19 had recently recorded and managed seven (7) active and confirmed COVID-19 cases from different barangays of this municipality;

WHEREAS, the Local Task Force Against Covid-19 has convened and thoroughly assessed the current situation and strongly recommended to implement the Zoning Containment Strategy and Community Quarantine in accordance to the National IATF Memorandum Circular No. 2, s. 2020 and Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, owing to the current situation, it is deemed necessary to implement the recommendation of the Local Task Force Against Covid-19, to effectively subdue the spread of the disease;

WHEREAS, RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the municipality shall exercise powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MACARIO N. NAPULAN, MD, Municipal Mayor of Miagao, Iloilo, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby **IMPLEMENT THE ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY AND COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN SELECTED AREAS/BARANGAYS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MIAGAO UNTIL AUGUST 31, 2020 FOR STRONGER PROTECTION AGAINST THE CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)**, and order the following:

**APPLICATION OF ZONE CLASSIFICATIONS IN SELECTED AREAS/BARANGAYS**

**1.1 CRITICAL ZONE (Enhanced Community Quarantine)**

**1. House of Index Case at Barangay Ubos Ilaya, Miagao, Iloilo**

The following protocols shall be observed:

1. Minimum public health standards shall be complied with at all times and all household members to observe strict home quarantine.

## **1.2 CONTAINMENT ZONE (Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine)**

- 1. Barangay Ubos Ilaya**
- 2. Barangay Ubos Ilawod**

The following protocols shall be observed:

1. Minimum public health standards shall be complied with at all times;
2. Strict home quarantine shall be observed in all households, and the movement of all residents shall be limited to accessing essential goods and services, and for work in permitted offices or establishments;
3. Use of Community Quarantine Pass shall be implemented;
4. Any person below 21 years old, those who are 60 years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, or other health risks, and pregnant women, including any person who resides with the aforementioned, shall be required to remain in their residences at all times, except when indispensable under the circumstances for obtaining essential goods and services, or for work in industries and offices or such other permitted activities;
5. Only essential establishments shall be allowed to operate with maximum of 50% operational capacity;
6. Accommodation establishments shall not be allowed to operate;
7. Mass gatherings and non-essential work gatherings shall be prohibited. Religious gatherings shall be limited to not more than five (5) persons. However, gatherings that are essential for the provision of government services or authorized humanitarian activities shall be allowed;
8. Public transportation shall be suspended. This notwithstanding, commissioned shuttle services for employees of permitted offices or establishments, as well as point-to-point transport services provided by the government shall be allowed to operate, giving priority to healthcare workers.
9. Private transportation such as company shuttles and personal vehicles utilized by persons authorized outside their residences are allowed subject to the guidelines provided by DOTr. The use of bikes and other non-motorized transportation is strongly encouraged;
10. Individual outdoor exercises such as outdoor walks, jogging, running or biking are allowed within MECQ areas. Provided, that the minimum health standards and precautions such as the wearing of masks and the maintenance of social distancing protocols are observed;
11. Curfew hours from 8:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. shall be observed;
12. The barangay officials, local task forces and Barangay Health Emergency Response Teams shall establish 24/7 checkpoint and border control;
13. Proper hygiene, cleanliness and sanitation measures shall be observed in the Barangay; and
14. Barangays to monitor compliance of establishments on their adherence to the minimum health standards and protocols.

## **1.3 BUFFER ZONE (General Community Quarantine)**

- 1. Barangay Bagumbayan**
- 2. Barangay Mat-y**
- 3. Barangay Tacas**
- 4. Nonato Extension, Baybay Norte**


The following protocols shall be observed:

1. Minimum public health standards shall be complied with at all times for the duration;
2. The movement of all persons in areas placed under GCQ shall be limited to accessing essential goods and services, and for work in the offices or industries permitted to operate. Provided, that movement for leisure purposes shall not be allowed;
3. Any person below twenty-one (21) years old, those who are sixty (60) years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, or other health risks, and pregnant women, including any person who resides with the aforementioned, shall be required to remain in their residences at all times, except when indispensable under the circumstances for obtaining essential goods and services or for work in permitted industries and offices;
4. Work in all government offices may be at full operational capacity or under such alternative work arrangements as agencies may deem proper in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations;
5. Alternative work arrangements such as flexible work arrangements, compressed work week, telework, and telecommuting is strongly encouraged.
6. All permitted establishments and activities shall be allowed to operate or be undertaken at full operational capacity. In addition, the following sectors or industries shall be allowed to operate at an operational capacity provided herein:
  - A) Category I Industries - Power, energy, water, and other utilities, agriculture, fishery, and forestry industries, food manufacturing and food supply chain businesses, including food retail establishments such as supermarkets, grocery stores, and food preparation establishments insofar as take-out and delivery services, food delivery services, health-related establishments, the logistics sector, information technology and telecommunication companies, the media, at full operational capacity;
  - B) Category II Industries - Mining and other manufacturing, and electronic commerce companies, as well as other delivery, repair and maintenance, and housing and office services, at anywhere between fifty percent (50%) up to full operational capacity, and without prejudice to work-from-home and other alternative work arrangements; and
  - C) Category III Industries - Financial services, legal and accounting, and auditing services, professional, scientific, technical, and other non-leisure services, barbershops and salons and other non-leisure wholesale and retail establishments, from skeleton workforce to fifty percent (50%) operational capacity, and without prejudice to work-from-home and other alternative work arrangements;
7. All public and private construction projects shall be allowed, but with strict compliance to the construction safety guidelines issued by the DPWH for the implementation of infrastructure projects during the COVID-19 pandemic.
8. Amusement, gaming, and fitness establishments, as well as those in the kids and the tourism industries, and all Category IV industries may not operate.
9. Mass gatherings such as but not limited to, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, community assemblies, and non-essential work gatherings shall be prohibited. Gatherings that are for the provision of critical government services and authorized humanitarian activities while adhering to the prescribed minimum health standards shall be allowed. Religious gatherings shall be limited to not more than ten (10) persons;
10. Outdoor non-contact sports and other forms of exercise such as but not limited to walking, jogging, running, biking, and the like are allowed. Provided, that the minimum public health standards such as the wearing of masks and the maintenance of social distancing protocols, and no sharing of equipment where applicable, are observed;

11. The barangay officials, local task forces and Barangay Health Emergency Response Teams shall establish 24/7 checkpoint and border control;
12. Proper hygiene, cleanliness and sanitation measures shall be observed in the Barangay; and
13. Barangays to monitor compliance of establishments on their adherence to the minimum health standards and protocols.

This order shall take effect immediately.
